

By the 12th century, the medieval knight was wearing a helmet that covered his face in battle. As a result it was difficult to know friend from foe. To help a knight identify who was an enemy and who was a friend on the field of battle, knights began to wear certain colors and adopt certain symbols that identified them as vassals of a certain lord or members of a particular family. By the 15th century the use of these colors and symbols had become standardized and is known as, heraldry.

Each Noble family had their own heraldry or coat of arms (the symbolic images seen on a knight's shield. Individuals would have variations of the basic family coat or arms that showed their status or individual achievements. As a result one could read the images on some ones coat of arms and know what family they belonged to, where in that family they stood, and other important facts about them.

Your task is to create a coat of arms for yourself. On the blank shield provided you are to create a coat of arms that reflects who you are, what traits you admire, or what you wish to obtain.

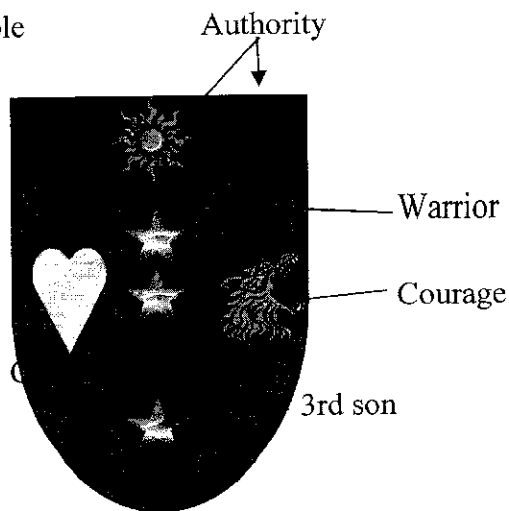
1: Select a pattern design for your shield taking into account their meanings

Since the designs often separate the shield into different areas each area can be used to show something different

2: Pick back ground colors being sure to refer to the colors meaning chart as to what it means. For the different areas of your shield

3: select symbols that have meaning to you and add them to your shield, either over several areas or in individual areas.








Remember, you do not have to use the exact image shown in the chart, any image or a dog, realistic or symbolic

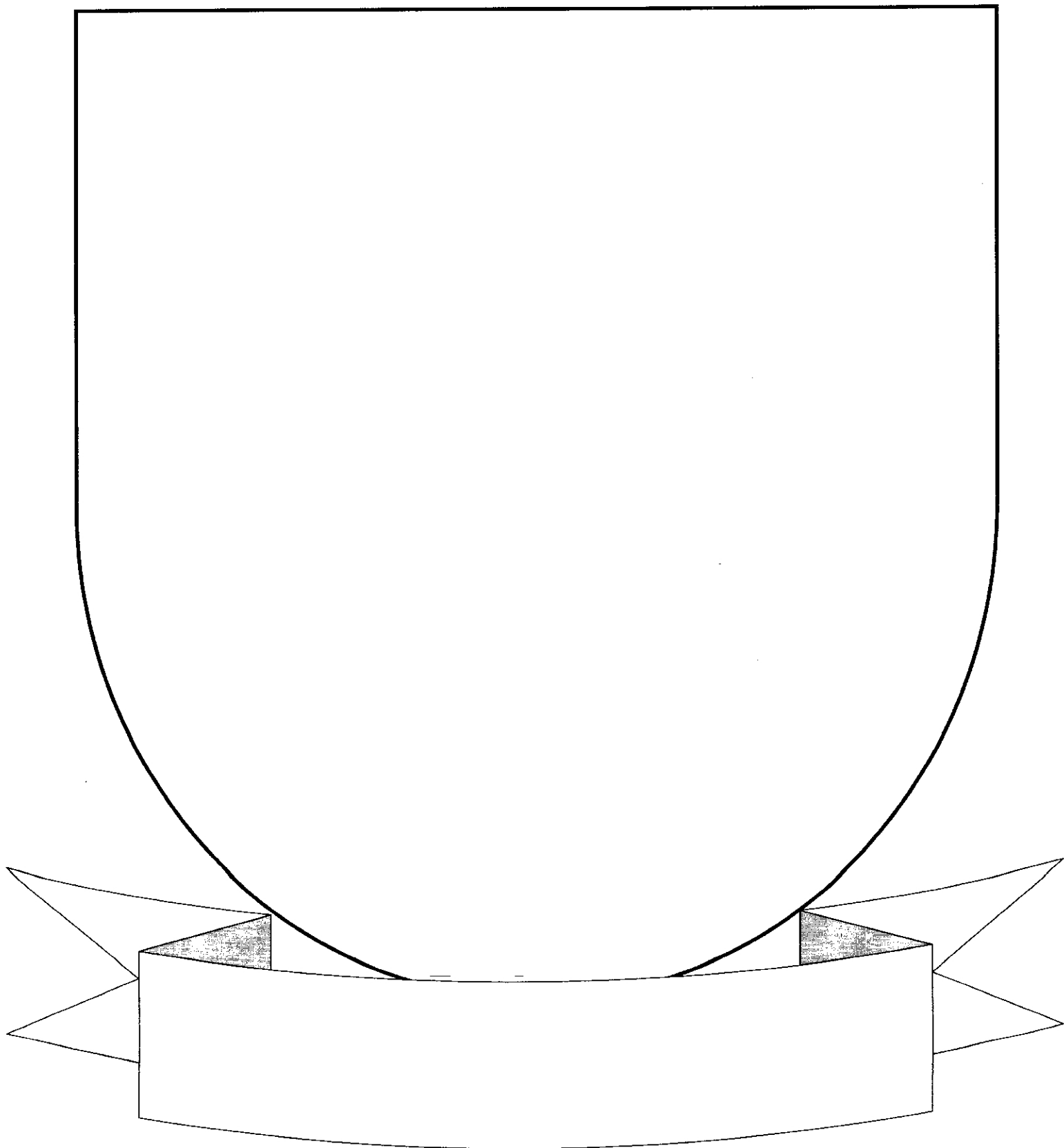
